



## Public Sector Apprenticeship Target Report 2019

### Introduction

Public sector bodies with 250 or more staff have a target set by the government to employ an average of at least 2.3% of their staff as new apprentice starts each year. As a public sector body in scope of this target, we must 'have regard' to the target and must publish our data annually.

This reporting period ran from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019.

G: The number of apprentices immediately before this period.	2
H: Number of employees employed immediately before this period.	635
I: Percentage of workforce that were apprentices immediately before this period.	0.3%

### Notes

Figure A is higher than might normally be expected because it includes 91 staff TUPE transferred to the Trust in this period, upon academy conversion of Whiston Willis Primary Academy and Yew Tree Primary Academy.
