

Public Sector Apprenticeship Target Report 2020

Introduction

Public sector bodies with 250 or more staff have a target set by the government to employ an average of at least 2.3% of their staff as new apprentice starts each year. As a public sector body in scope of this target, we must 'have regard' to the target and must publish our data annually.

This reporting period ran from 1st April 2019 to 31st March 2020.
