



## Public Sector Apprenticeship Target Report 2020

### Introduction

Public sector bodies with 250 or more staff have a target set by the government to employ an average of at least 2.3% of their staff as new apprentice starts each year. As a public sector body in scope of this target, we must 'have regard' to the target and must publish our data annually.

This reporting period ran from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020.
